4 Colors of money:

- (Gold) Give it- (Mal.3:8, 1 Cor.16 and 2 Cor.8,9, Is.55:1)
- (Green) Save it- (Prov.13:22, Prob. 21:20, Ecc.5:10)
- (Blue) Spend it- (Prov. 27:23-24, Heb. 13:5, Mt. 6:25, Jas. 4:3)
- (Red) Repay debt-(Rom. 13:8, Pro.22:7, Dt.28:12)

Dealing with the Blue Box: "Spend less than you earn"

• You can live on less when you have more to live for.

Change in perspective. The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field.
